Fundraising

Annual dinner, giving & tithing: This year the annual fundraising dinner will be on Saturday, February 21, 2015. You have plenty of time to make arrangements to be here, so we will expect to see your bright and smiling face! We love having those of you who come to the annual dinner, and those of you who donate but are unable to be here.

Our annual fund raising dinner is the only real fund raiser we usually do, and the money we raise helps to keep us going throughout the entire year. It is very important to our ongoing operations, as running this school and church is an expensive undertaking. We depend on your donations and much appreciate them.

Although you can donate without coming to the dinner, we would prefer that you be here. You will be among the best people on the planet. You can bring friends, partners and spouses, etc. The charge is \$150 per person. Start saving and /or donating now!

Tithing: We are very grateful for those of you who tithe. You are very consistent, which allows us to have a dependable income source. Most churches have regular tithing; many churches ask for tithing pledges at the beginning of the year.

Tithing means giving regularly. It is a way of tapping into the abundant flow of the universe. The natural flow is there, but you need to tap into it, and that is what you do when you tithe. It's like a river that keeps flowing; holding onto your money separates you from that natural flow, like the river getting dammed up. When you give willingly and without expectation, you become a part of the existing natural abundant flow. It creates a source of abundance for all.

You can tithe any amount, even if it's only \$20 per month. We can charge your credit card monthly, or you can use Paypal on the website, or just send in a monthly check. Some people tithe \$20, some \$50, some \$100, some \$200, and everything in-between. Everything helps, and it keeps the energy flowing for all of us.

The Church is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, so your tithes (and all donations) are tax-deductible, as is your donation to the fund-raiser. Other people, particularly near the end of the year, are looking for tax-deductions to help with their taxes. Please ask some of those folks for a donation!


Blessing
